I have been very happy with the zoom, the image stabilizer, 3" hi resolution screen, you can zoom while using the movie feature, and the quality of the pictures. Get the TZ5 not the 4 to get the updated movie ability. The camera cost about \$250 but with a better battery, a tripod, and larger memory it ended up at about \$350. I believe they are cheaper now. The only negative so far is that it is not a small purse camera. It will fit in a pocket but not comfortably.
