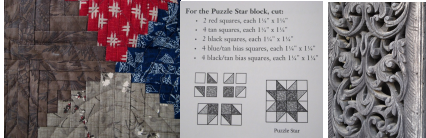

Coasters are always a welcome gift, but why not make them even more outstanding than the commercially produced available almost everywhere. We loved this idea ([An Oregon Cottage](#)) of using pages from favorite books or sheets of music. We thought it might be fun to take the idea a bit further to show a love of quilting:



For the Puzzle Star block, you:
• 2 red squares, each $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$
• 4 tan squares, each $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$
• 2 black squares, each $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$
• 4 Maroon tan squares, each $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$
• 4 Black tan squares, each $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$

- Print pages using detailed images of your quilted work
- Print pages from favorite quilt pattern directions
- Print pages of quilt designs or interesting patterns from your vacations
