This is the sixth in a series of quilts using circles to abstract and simplify an image. I like to see how far I can push the abstraction and still be able to find the original images. There are six roses in this quilt. Can you see all of them? They are easier to find if you stand further away.

Techniques: Machine quilting (free-motion), fused appliqué, hand dyeing

Materials: Artist's hand-dyed cottons, fusible web
