Her quilt, called *Isn't it Romantic?*, was a judged quilt and won 2 ribbons! 1st place for **One Person Machine Appliqué Machine Quilted** and also for **Exemplary Machine Appliqué**.



Nancy started with a pattern by Esther Aliu, stitching a blanket stitch on her old BERNINA. She said she loved the thunk sound her old BERNINA made :) Nancy uses 2 batts in her quilts, one cotton and one wool with the wool one on top. She says the wool batt when quilting provides dimension to her quilts, and as you can see she knows what she is doing!
