Lesson 3—Intensity, 8" x 8"

From a medium fabric (preferably multi-colored), cut 1 square, 4" x 4" for the center.

From a dark fabric, cut 1 square, 4" x 4". Cut the square twice diagonally to make 4 large triangles.

From a light fabric, cut 4 rectangles, 2" x 4", for the background. Lay the light rectangles in the background areas first, then lay the large triangles over them. (Much easier than cutting 8 triangles for the background!)

From a medium-dark fabric, cut 4 squares, 2" x 2", for the corners.

Strive for **consistency** in the intensity of your fabrics, whether you have chosen to work with intense color or low-intensity color.
