Lesson 4—Color wheel combinations, 8" x 8"

You'll need four different fabrics, so if you choose a combination with four colors, such as a tetrad, you'll need one fabric in each color. If you choose a combination with fewer than four colors, you'll need to repeat one or more of the colors. (I suggest putting the fourth fabric in the background, as a light value.)

From a medium fabric (could be multi-colored, if it fits your chosen combination), cut 1 square, 4" x 4" for the center.

From a dark fabric, cut 1 square, 4" x 4". Cut the square twice diagonally to make 4 large triangles.

From a light fabric, cut 4 rectangles, 2" x 4", for the background. Lay the light rectangles in the background areas first, then lay the large triangles over them. (Much easier than cutting 8 triangles for the background!)

From a medium-dark fabric, cut 4 squares, 2" x 2", for the corners.
