



Lesson 5—Magic Fabrics, 9" x 9"

For the center square, choose a magic fabric that has gradated value/color, or is "shot with light." This fabric should be the lightest in value to make the center square recede.

For the inner round, select a dark-value fabric.

For the middle round, select a medium-value fabric.

For the outer round, select a medium-light-value fabric. This round should be *slightly* darker than the center square, so the center recedes the most and seems to be the most distant.

Make your mock-block in Log Cabin style, beginning with the shortest log (above the center square) and working *counter-clockwise*.
