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Lesson 6—Layered Transparency, 8" x 8"

Cut the outer shapes from medium-dark fabrics. Cut the inner shapes from light (but not *too* light) fabrics. The outer pieces and the inner pieces should contrast enough to read as two distinct areas. Also, the outer pieces should be the same relative value (medium-dark). The same is true of the inner pieces; they should have the same degree of lightness. Glue the outer pieces first, then glue the inner pieces on top.
