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## Lesson 7—Luminosity, 8" x 8"

Cut the outer shapes from cool, dark, low-intensity fabrics ("cool, dark, and duller").

Cut the inner shapes from warm, medium, intense fabrics ("warm, medium, and brighter").

The outer pieces should have the same relative value; that is, the same degree of darkness.

The same is true of the inner pieces; they should have the same relative value (medium).

Hint: Don't go *too* dark or *too* dull with the outer pieces; you need some slightly brighter and slightly lighter colors to keep the background from looking drab.
