



## Lesson 9—Opalescence, 8" x 8"

From *each* of four *different* opal-like fabrics\*, cut:

1 square, 2" by 2". Cut the squares once diagonally to yield 4 half-square triangles for the inner triangles (A). (One of each will be left over.) \*Hint: If you don't have 4 different fabrics, cut 4 triangles from one opal-like fabric.

Repeat with 4 *different* slightly darker, slightly duller fabrics for triangles (B).

From *each* of four *different* medium-light to medium-dark fabrics, cut:

1 rectangle, 2" by 4", for the surrounding rectangles (C).

From *each* of two *different* lighter-value fabrics, cut:

2 squares, each 2" by 2", for the corners (D).
