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*Embellishments for quilting and crazy quilting are plentiful but have you considered the addition of a lovely fabric image, ribbons, trims and small ribbon flowers? This is an easy project for all skill levels.*

### **You Will Need:**

Fabric - one piece dupioni silk fabric, 4" x 6" or 5" x 7"

Scraps of three other fabrics sized about 5" x 3" each

Fusible cotton stabilizer - one piece, 4" x 6" or 5" x 7"

Fabric print - image size up to 3" tall x 2 1/2" wide

One piece of thin batting - 3" x 2 1/2"

7" of 3" wide lace

5" of 1/4" wide copper ribbon

7" of 1/2" wide fancy black/green jacquard ribbon

18" of 1/2" wide teal ribbon

9" of blue loop trim

9" of green leaf trim

2 large cream lace leaves

Four pre-made ribbon flowers

Seed beads in teal, or gold for embellishing the fabric print and other ribbons on the postcard.

#10 milliners' needles, white ribbon work thread, ruler, tacky glue, and scissors

*Optional:* Cardstock - one piece cream colored, 4" x 6" or 5" x 7"

*Optional:* porcelain flowers, glass leaf bead, tassel, button, and porcelain urn.
