Top 100 Puzzle - DashBoard Saints - Terrie Hancock

This is one of the largest quilts created by Terrie Hancock, generally considered one of the first artists to work in mixed media and embellishment. In the late 1980s she began painting on canvas. Terrie then cut up the canvas and worked them into quilts. The quilt measures 123" x 99" and was quilted by Sue Rule in 1985. It is made of cottons and cotton blends, is hand applied and machine pieced, reverse appliqued, embroidered, and uses beadwork and other embellishment.
